**Mental and Emotional Support Advocates (MESA):** Committed Long-term volunteers trained to partner with and support homeless clients to navigate the often lengthy process of finding a home.

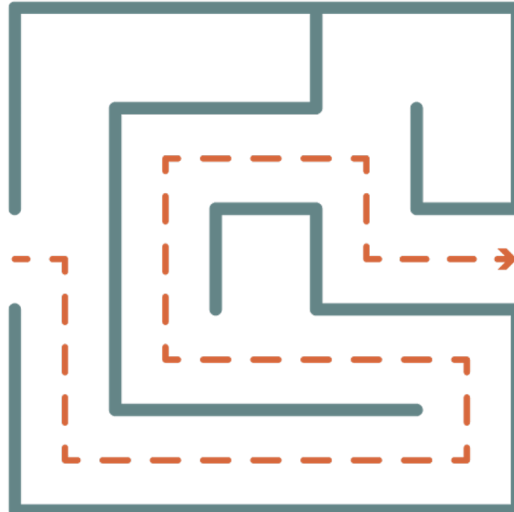

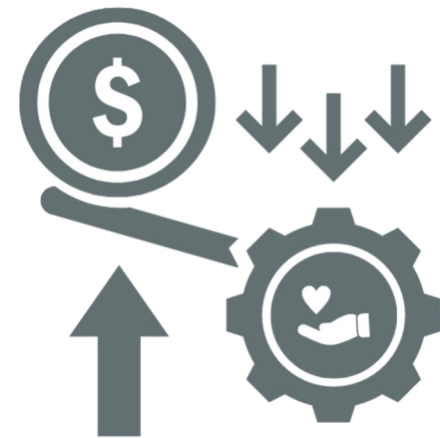

- *Expand our MESA-certified volunteer base to reach more of the homeless who will benefit from help navigating their way.*
