OUR GOALS

Partner with existing non-profit service providers and amplify their results:

- Our MESA-certified volunteers improve the rate of success placing sheltered individuals and families into living situations.
- Cost effective leverage of other NPO services through our managed volunteers.
- Improved NPO results.

Financials

- · Initial model:
 - \$250,000 Annual Budget delivers:
 - 20 Active Volunteers who invest 4-8 hours a week as many as 10,000 hours a year
 - Plus, management, administration, reporting, support team, and Jack Fuller full time.
 - In all, first year goal is to deliver the equivalent of 6-10 person-years, which would cost at least \$60,000 each
